

What does a Catholic funeral involve?

The Catholic funeral rite is called the Order of Christian Funerals. The Order is made up of three main celebrations. The first is called the Vigil for the Deceased. This vigil is a prayer service that usually takes place in the funeral home during one of the visitation periods before the funeral. It includes a solemn reading of the Word of God and prayers for the deceased and those who mourn. The principal celebration is the funeral Mass. The Rite of Committal, the conclusion of the funeral rites, is celebrated at the cemetery. Prayers are offered to commit the body of the deceased to its final resting place. In committing the body to its resting place, the community expresses the hope that, like all those who have gone before, marked with the sign of faith, the deceased awaits the glory of the resurrection.
