# What Makes a Cremation Catholic?

## The Church, the Liturgy, the Catholic Cemetery

The Church has accepted cremation since 1963. Our loved one's ashes should be treated with the same reverence and respect given to the physical body. This means that the full liturgy of Christian Burial be carried out whenever possible. These rites include a visitation, a funeral Mass and burial in a Catholic Cemetery.

Following the most ancient Christian tradition, the Church asks that the faithful, in preparing their funeral and burial arrangements, ensure that the bodies of Catholics are buried in a grave, a mausoleum or a columbarium as soon as possible after cremation has taken place.



Scattering cremated remains on the sea, in the air, on the ground, or keeping them in the home of a relative does not display appropriate reverence.

There is a spiritual and emotional benefit for placing cremated remains in a proper place of burial. It gives the bereaved and the Church community a place to focus remembrance and pray for the deceased. Such a place will make it easier to memorialize those that have been called home to God.

## Cremation Burial Options

At Catholic Cemeteries, we provide dignified and sacred spaces for the interment of cremated remains, maintaining the sanctity and reverence prescribed by the Church. Our facilities offer various options for the final resting place of ashes, including in-ground burials and indoor and outdoor columbarium niches. We also operate our own Catholic crematorium providing assurance to families that the cremation takes place with the reverence consistent with Catholic tradition.
